**EPC** programs

The EPC is on the forefront of the effort to ensure everyone has a chance to go to college:

- raising students' and families' awareness of the benefits of college and the pathways to entrance and completion
- helping high school students envision themselves at college through on-campus experiences including interactions with undergraduates and university faculty
- providing academic preparation, information about paying for college, assistance with college and financial aid applications, and training in STEM skills

#### EPC's programs are proven and effective:

Alumni have a significantly better record entering and succeeding in community college and universities. The EPC's vision is that every student in the region will be prepared to enter and succeed in college.



**GEAR UP** and **EAOP**: creates a college-going culture and helps high schoolers prepare academically and navigate their path to higher education

MESA and Girls in Engineering: intensive, hands-on introduction to pursuing education and careers in science, technology, engineering, and math (STEM)

**COSMOS**: on-campus residential STEM summer program taught by UCSC researchers and faculty

CalSOAP and ETS: promotes higher education and college affordability while preparing students for academic success and access to college
